Dayton Daily News/Cox Ohio Publishing

RSI was contracted to plan and manage the collocation of 750 Cox Ohio Publishing (Dayton Daily News) employees from four locations into one. From these locations Cox Ohio Publishing produces five local daily papers and operates 24 hours a day. The timing surrounding various departmental moves was very sensitive as the public expects their news and expects it on time. RSI was also responsible for coordination of all items moving, disconnection and reconnecting services for IT equipment and planning for the relocation of all archived and historical research materials.



AK Steel

RSI was selected to budget for, plan, and manage the relocation of AK Steel's 330 employee headquarters from Middletown, Ohio to West Chester, Ohio. And although our main responsibility was the coordination of the physical move of furniture and contents, additionally, the RSI team created RFP's for furniture vendor selection, IT vendor selection, commercial mover and packing materials vendor selection.

Relocation Strategies also coordinated the purchase of 40 used office desk sets and 80 used chairs. On the construction management portion of the project, RSI worked closely with Duke Realty Construction for the completion of the post move punch list.

In May, 2007 Relo Strat Inc. Charlotte was awarded the contract to manage the move process for FDS's headquarters renovation project in Charlotte. This project will extend thru September, 2008 and involve 19 phases. Approximately 600 employees are impacted by the move. Our goal has been to provide a seamless transition for the employees as they are relocated. Through the initial phases of the project planning, the physical contents and equipment moves have gone extremely well.

Socrates Academy

Relo Strat Inc. Charlotte was contracted to plan and move the entire contents of this Charter School at the close of the school year to their new school facility in Matthews, NC. The planning, orientation, and training went smoothly. However, when the building was delayed, we assisted with securing storage tailors for all the physical contents which were then moved into a storage facility. Six weeks later we managed the successful delivery and installation of the school furniture, supplies, and equipment.

Center for Advanced Medicine and Clinical Research

Provided the move management for this international clinic known for successfully treating "untreatable conditions." The planning and execution of the relocation of their Center to a new Headquarters facility in Huntersville, NC included all the medical equipment, specialized chambers, supplements, contents, and furniture and was completed so that the clinic was operational throughout the move.

Scott comes to us most recently from Graebel Van Lines where he worked to develop new business and negotiated contracts for such accounts as NASA Glen Research Center, The University of Akron and Forest City Enterprises.

Procter and Gamble can also take credit for his experience. He has worked ongoing with P&G for nearly four years before his return to Cleveland. While on these various projects he has been responsible for employee, fixtures and equipment, mechanical labs and even international relocation projects. Employee relocations ranged from as few as five to as many as 1600 scattered throughout the various campuses located in Cincinnati, Ohio. New furniture had to be integrated with transfers of the existing furniture. The mechanical labs proved a labyrinth of specialists that needed to balance, pressurize and level all types of equipment in coordination with installation. The international project consisted of relocating segmented divisions from four different countries to their new International Headquarters in Geneva, Switzerland. Overcoming the language barriers in order to handle customs and border controls was a feat in itself. While planning and logistics carried on for over a year, 650 employees transferred into the new headquarters in just two months.
